#### Teams and Student Performance Groups Admission

Students, coaches, directors and escorts will be admitted to the stadium by uniform. Personal items should be limited to necessity for the performance. Groups are to be admitted through designated gates and not ticketed patron entry gates.

#### Parking | Gates | Security Procedures

- Lots available at Hays High School, Live Oak Academy and Barton Middle School for parking. Central lot between the stadium and campus is available for a fee and may be pre-sold through the athletic department or booster clubs.
- Patrons can gain access to the stadium through the east gate for entry.
- Limited personal items will be allowed into the stadium. Bags that are approved are: clear tote bags, 1-gallon plastic freezer bags, small clutch purses that do not exceed 5.5" x 8.5", and wallets. #### GENERAL RULES FOR BOB SHELTON STADIUM

- Please always display respect and good sportsmanship.
- Alcohol, tobacco, smoking, illegal substances, or firearms are prohibited.
- No pets, except service animals, are allowed.
- No backpacks are allowed.
- Outside food and drink are strictly prohibited.
- For patron safety, umbrellas are not allowed in the stadium.
- No noisemakers are permitted in the stadium.
- Once you leave the stadium, you will be required to purchase a ticket to return. (No in and out privileges.)
- Hays CISD reserves the right to remove anyone from the stadium at any time

## General Information

#### Stadium Seating

- Seating Capacity Total 8,600
- Home seating 5,000 with 319 seats with permanent back rest | Visitor seating 3,600
- Wheelchair and handicapped accessible seating on both home and visitor sides.

#### Playing Surface

Artificial Turf- Our turf provides excellent traction as well as light deflection under the lights to provide the competing teams with an excellent playing surface.

#### Press box Facilities

- Multi-level home press box with 2 media booths on 1st floor and two 2nd floor film decks
- Single Level visitor press box with a 2nd level film deck

#### **Dressing Rooms**

- One home and one visitor dressing room in the stadium
- Home dressing with 96 full lockers and taping room | Visitor dressing with 96 one-half lockers and taping table.

#### **Ticketing Information**

- Three ticket booths and entry gates on the North, South, and East side of stadium
- North and South gates serve both Home and Visitor guest
- East gate serves the Home guest only

#### Restroom Facilities

- Home restrooms are located on the concourse under the Home bleachers and include a separate family changing room.
- Visitor restrooms are located on the south end under the visitor bleachers.


#### **Concession Stands**

- Home concessions are located on the concourse under the home bleachers
- Visitor concessions are located in the south end of the stadium with an alternative concession in the North end of the visitor bleachers.

#### **Parking**

## Stadium Policies

### **Dressing Facilities**

- Open 3 hours prior to event time
- No towels, coolers or water provided
- Although dressing rooms will be locked and monitored, HCISD is not responsible for any articles left in dressing facilities before, during or after events.

#### **Competition Area**

- All personnel who are not team personnel will need a sideline / field pass. Sideline passes will be sent to each school prior to event when possible or given to the coaching staff
- Spirit lines may consist of uniformed groups only
- Tobacco, chewing gum, sunflower seeds and peanuts are prohibited on the track / turf area
- No glass and food allowed on track / turf area
- No live mascots
- No cannons, noise makers or confetti
- No props that will mark or cut track / turf surface
- No long metal spikes or metal cleats may be used
- No decoration of facilities including goal posts or fencing
- No paper signs with water-based paint
- Schools may have run-through signs that are only used at the beginning of the game or after half-time. No spirit signs
  allowed other than cheerleader props. Any debris from run-through signs must be removed immediately from track / turf
  area.
- Spectators are not allowed on the track / turf area before, during or after the event.
- If a blow up is used at the beginning of game and/or halftime, this group will be allowed on field during the beginning of game and at halftime for this purpose only. They must have ticket to game and be in bleachers at all other times.

#### Ticket Booths and Gates

- Gates will open 90 minutes prior to event start time unless otherwise indicated.
- No in and out privileges -a ticket will be required for each entry.
- No food, beverages, containers, pets or backpacks may be brought through entry gates.
- No food, ice chests, or coolers allowed in the stadium except for teams and support groups.

#### **Bleachers**

- No climbing over, standing or sitting on bleacher rails.
- No signage or decorations allowed in the bleachers or on stadium fencing.
- Loitering is strictly prohibited in the concourse area.
- Movement from one side of the stadium to the other is prohibited without prior authorization from the Stadium Manager.
- Hays CISD reserves the right to assign seating to any or all fans.

#### Press Box

- Facility will be open to coaches and/or directors 3 hours prior to event start.
- Access to East press box is through elevator located at main entry on East side of stadium.
- Admittance to press box will require proper credentials or a pass except for coaches and directors in uniform.
